

Woman Charged With Killing Cousin In Fight Over Fries

Suspect Found In Hotel Room With White Castle Bags

CHICAGO -- A 19-year-old Chicago woman has been charged with murder for allegedly stabbing her cousin to death during a quarrel over a 99-cent box of french fries.

Police say Antoinette Jenkins and her cousin Antoine Jenkins, also 19, had visited a White Castle hamburger restaurant on the West side early Sunday morning and were on the street near their home when they began fighting over the box of fries. Antoinette allegedly grabbed a knife and stabbed her cousin once in his heart.

Antoinette Jenkins was arrested later in the day at a hotel.
